Update Access materials on the website Finally updating all the access materials on the website, which have been last updated 3 years ago such as: Freshers Guide, Undergraduate and Postgraduate Application Guides, Information packages about the UK Health care system and the UK immigration system. Uploading recent Personal Statements to the website (Only one PS has been uploaded in the last 3 years)

Access Events Holding a Big Access event in Budapest to prospective applicants, which we would film and uploaded to the website to make it accessible to everyone. Besides this we would aim to organise several other access talks across the country building on the connections of the current members of CUHS. Holding a webinar, which would be an interactive skype session where we would give an access presentation and answer questions. This would enable us to reach schools and students way beyond our scope.

Scholarships and bursaries We plan to provide a better overview of the scholarships and bursaries available to Hungarian students. Currently our website only provides information on university wide financial opportunities. We plan to explore opportunities in different colleges as well as provide information on scholarships available in Hungary (NKFIH, NFTÖ, MOL etc.)

College Guide Make a short Informal Guide about each college, where we would ask a Hungarian from each college to give a short description about their colleges, to give prospective applicants a sense about what each college is like.

Mentoring program We plan to upgrade our mentoring program. Currently we provide support to students who have already made their decision on subject and/or college application. We plan to launch introductory mentoring sessions where we provide prospective applicants with recommendations and choose their mentors based on their interests.

Brexit We plan to update the information provided about the implications of Brexit on applicants and keep informing them about updates on crucial points including the tuition fee status, loans, bursaries and scholarships.

Involvement of postgraduates Most of the access officers' work has been around undergraduate applicants. We wish to change this and reach out to mature and graduate students both as applicants and society members. We propose to collaborate with a postgraduate student on this matter and establish the postgraduate officer position.

Keeping up the good work Maintain the now usual tasks of the access officers, such as organising the offer holder's day, making the group chat for prospective applicants and offer holders, arranging accommodation for applicants, who wish to arrive or stay 1 extra day during interviews, and help the events officers with the organising of the Fresher's Camp.
